**Installation:**

Install SEDUM TILE® directly over a minimum 2" freshly wetted and leveled growth media. Maintain good overall contact with the media avoiding gaps between and beneath the TILE®. Water thoroughly after installation. Overhead irrigation is recommended twice weekly for 3-4 weeks. Plantings installed during very cool fall weather may need only initial irrigation.

**Storage:**

- Store sedum tiles outside before planting. If hot, move them to a shady location. Protect them from frost and harsh winds.
- Sedum Tile can be stored in a cool warehouse for up to two days. The sedum tiles may remain in the pallet shipper trays for a maximum of two days before they must be unpacked and exposed to light/ air. Water thoroughly once every three days.

Water thoroughly after installation. Overhead irrigation is recommended twice weekly for 3-4 weeks. Plantings installed during very cool fall weather may need only initial irrigation.

**Storage:**

- Store sedum tiles outside before planting. If hot, move them to a shady location. Protect them from frost and harsh winds.
- Sedum Tile can be stored in a cool warehouse for up to two days. The sedum tiles may remain in the pallet shipper trays for a maximum of two days before they must be unpacked and exposed to light/ air. Water thoroughly once every three days.
